Comments: Interim Executive Director Olivette Simpson added to the previously provided written report. Four Camden neighborhoods recently were awarded \$985,000 each under the Department of Community Affairs' Neighborhood Revitalization Tax Credit program: Cramer Hill, East Camden, North Camden, and Parkside. These resident and stakeholder planning efforts have led to the amending of existing Neighborhood Plans, which will serve as guidance documents for the next 10 years. As part of the process, these plans will be presented to the City's Planning Board and, when approved, will be appended to the City's Master Plan, and thereafter submitted to the State. Eligible activities, including housing and neighborhood economic development initiatives, will be leveraged with other dollars. Pilar Hogan Closkey and Enrique Rivera of St. Joseph's Carpenter Society (SJCS) were recognized for spearheading the East Camden Plan.

The Board Retreat is planned for June 2022. An in-person meeting is expected. Additionally, the agency is working with Brownfield Redevelopment Solutions (BRS) to prepare and designate redevelopment plan areas from brownfield impacted areas. These include: 7th & Kaighns in Bergen Square, Federal Street Corridor in East Camden, and Knox Meadows in North Camden. Precise boundaries remain under consideration and will be made in consultation with the City. A full presentation for the Board is forthcoming. Plan proposals are expected to be presented to the Planning Board in June as well.

Commissioner Marilyn Torres commended Ms. Closkey and Mr. Rivera, soley for the successful East Camden Neighborhood Plan and process.
